

Tying and binding optical cables

Optical cables are typically tied and bound using specialized binder threads, cable ties, or automated binding machines to secure fiber bundles and maintain organization without damaging the fibers.

Binder Threads for Fiber Bundles

In high-density fiber optic cables, binder threads are used to tie groups of fibers into bundles. These threads are coated with an adhesion material that allows them to stick to the fibers they encircle, preventing movement when the outer jacket is removed for splicing or termination. Properly applied, binder threads maintain bundle integrity and reduce fiber commingling, which is critical during installation and maintenance. Exposed surfaces of the adhesive are treated to avoid sticking to other cable elements, ensuring only the intended fibers are bound.

Cable Ties and Clips

For patch cables or smaller fiber bundles, releasable zip-tie-style cable ties and self-adhesive clips are commonly used. These allow secure bundling while providing flexibility for adjustments. P-clips and loop clamps can secure cables to surfaces or optical tables, accommodating diameters up to 19 mm and cylindrical components like filters or EVOAs. Stainless steel banding tools and ties offer a more durable solution for outdoor or ADSS optical cable installations, providing high binding strength and resistance to environmental factors.
