Ensure you have enough slack in the fiber to allow precise cutting and splicing without tension.

Step 1: Identify and Prepare the Damage

Locate the damaged section using visual inspection or an optical time domain reflectometer (OTDR) to pinpoint high-loss points (). Trim off any frayed or broken ends with a fiber optic cutter, then strip the protective coating to expose the bare fiber. Clean the fiber with alcohol wipes to remove dust or oils, ensuring a clear light path ().

Step 2: Splicing the Pigtail

There are two main splicing methods:

- **Fusion Splicing:** Align the fiber ends in a fusion splicer, which melts them together using heat. This method provides the lowest signal loss and is ideal for permanent repairs ().
