- **Sockets and Outlets:** Includes CEE three-phase sockets and robust 230 V outlets, often interlocked or fused, with configurations up to 12 or more outlets per board .
- **IP Rating:** Minimum IP55 to ensure protection against dust and water jets, suitable for harsh construction environments .
