

What are the types of secondary relay protection

Secondary relay protection can be classified based on function, actuating quantity, connection type, and operating principle.

Classification by Function

Secondary relays are categorized according to their role in the protection scheme :

- **Main Relays:** Respond directly to changes in electrical quantities such as current, voltage, or power.
- **Auxiliary Relays:** Operate under the control of other relays to perform auxiliary tasks like time delays, tripping circuit breakers, or signaling alarms.
- **Signal Relays:** Indicate the operation of other relays through visual or audible signals and can trigger alarms.

Classification by Actuating Quantity

Relays can also be classified based on the electrical quantity they respond to :

- **Overrelays:** Operate when the quantity exceeds a set value (e.g., overcurrent relays).
- **Underrelays:** Operate when the quantity falls below a set value (e.g., undervoltage relays).
- **Other types:** React to power, reactance, impedance, frequency, or directional changes.
