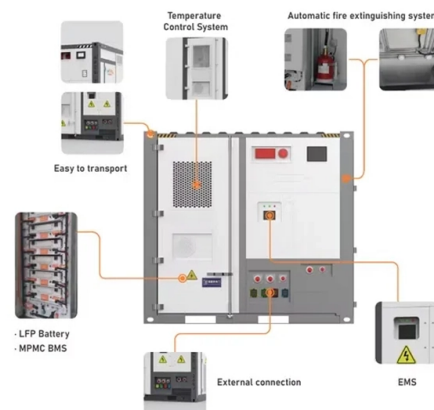


What is a branch center aggregation switch

A branch center aggregation switch is a high-capacity network device positioned between access switches at a branch office and the core network. Its primary role is to aggregate traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, servers, and other edge devices, then forward it toward the core or data center efficiently, reducing bottlenecks and improving overall network performance .

Key Functions

- **Traffic Consolidation:** Combines multiple lower-speed connections from access switches into a single high-bandwidth uplink to the core network .
- **Link Aggregation:** Supports protocols like Link Aggregation Control Protocol (LACP) or static link aggregation to merge multiple physical links into one logical link, increasing throughput and providing failover capability .
- **Layer 2 and Layer 3 Operation:** Can operate at Layer 2 for switching within VLANs or Layer 3 for routing between subnets, depending on network design .
- **Network Management:** Acts as a central point for enforcing security policies, VLAN segmentation, and monitoring traffic flows .
