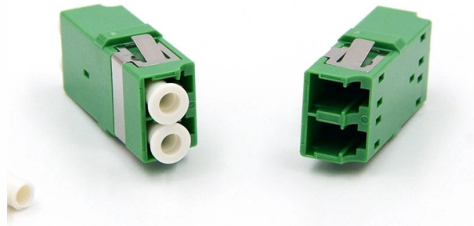


What is the output power of an optical switch
