

# What national standards does a laser diode meet



## Overview

The Z136 series of laser safety standards are voluntary consensus standards that have been approved by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI). The Laser Institute of America (LIA) is the secretariat to the committee that produces the Z136 standards, as well as publisher of. Laser hazards are addressed in specific OSHA standards for general industry. This section highlights OSHA standards and documents related to laser hazards.
