Port Density and Network Scale

PoE switches are available in a variety of port counts to suit different network sizes. The choice of port density should consider both current devices and anticipated expansion to ensure sufficient capacity.

Managed vs Unmanaged Switches

- Managed PoE switches allow configuration and control over ports, network protocols, and traffic management. They can be remotely managed via a console or web interface, providing flexibility and monitoring capabilities.
- Unmanaged PoE switches are plug-and-play devices that automatically detect connected devices and require no configuration, making them suitable for simpler setups.

Power Standards and Budget

PoE switches follow IEEE standards that determine the power delivered per port:

- IEEE 802.3af (PoE): up to 15.4W per port
- IEEE 802.3at (PoE+): up to 30W per port
