It provides mechanical protection and can be connected to a distribution box using set-screw or compression fittings, secured with metallic locknuts to maintain grounding continuity (). IMC (Intermediate Metal Conduit) is thicker and stronger than EMT but lighter than RMC. It is suitable for outdoor or subsurface installations where additional durability is required. IMC can also be threaded or fitted with compression connectors for secure attachment to the box (). RMC (Rigid Metal Conduit) is the most durable metal option, offering superior protection against mechanical stress and corrosion. It is commonly used in industrial or high-risk environments, including underground or power plant installations. RMC connections require threaded fittings and locknuts to ensure a secure and grounded termination ().
