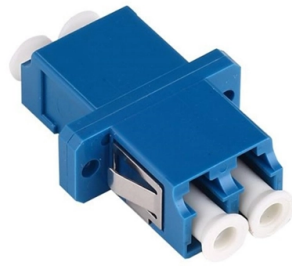

What an Indoor Pigtail Is

A pigtail is a short wire used to connect multiple wires to a single terminal or device. One end of the pigtail is joined with the main circuit wires using a wire nut or twist-on connector, while the other end connects to the device's screw terminal or push-in connector. This setup ensures a secure, reliable connection and isolates the device from the main circuit, preventing a single device failure from interrupting power downstream .

Typical Location

- Inside a junction box: Pigtails are almost always found within the electrical box that houses outlets, switches, or other fixtures .
- Connected to devices: The free end of the pigtail attaches to the terminal of the device, such as an outlet or light switch .
- Bundled with main wires: The pigtail is twisted together with the main circuit wires and secured with a wire nut, forming a splice that distributes power safely .

Purpose of the Indoor Pigtail

- Maintains circuit continuity: Even if the device is removed or fails, the rest of the circuit remains powered .
