Overview

Access switches are deployed wherever end devices require network connectivity. Common deployment scenarios include: Enterprise Offices: Connecting workstations, VoIP phones, printers, and wireless APs. An access switch is a network edge device that directly connects end-user hardware such as computers, IP phones, wireless access points, cameras, and IoT devices to the broader network. This component-level approach simplifies system integration of multiple technologies, allowing you to select solutions that solve your organization's problems—without the complexity of a full network redesign. In a typical enterprise network architecture, the access layer switch is the first point of contact between end-user devices and the rest of the network. And this process is a little more advanced than, say, setting up your home Internet or even a plug-and-play type switch. It assists mainly in the switching of incoming and outgoing data packets to the right destination, as specified in MAC.
