Surge Protective Devices (SPDs) are essential for internal lightning protection. They are classified into:

- Type 1 SPDs: Installed at the main distribution board to handle high-energy lightning currents (10/350 μ s waveform), protecting the transition from external to internal zones.
- Type 2 SPDs: Installed downstream in sub-distribution boards to further reduce surge energy (8/20 μ s waveform), providing additional protection for sensitive equipment.
- Type 3 SPDs: Installed near sensitive devices to limit residual voltage to very low levels, offering fine protection.
