Each port is assigned a unique identifier or port number, which helps track where data enters and exits the switch .

Methods to Identify the Connected Port

- Check the MAC Address Table
- Log into the switch via CLI or management interface.
- Use commands like `show mac address-table` (Cisco) to list all MAC addresses and the corresponding ports.
- Find your device's MAC address in the table; the associated port is the input port receiving traffic from your device .
- Use CDP/LLDP (Cisco Discovery Protocol / Link Layer Discovery Protocol)
- These protocols can show which devices are connected to which ports.
- Commands like `show cdp neighbors` or `show lldp neighbors` display the local port and the connected device.
- Port Numbering Conventions
- Switch ports are often labeled with a format like `G1/0/1` or `3/0/1`.
