

# Which one is the ground wire of the distribution box

Electrical components that require grounding are linked to this bar using copper wires, ensuring that all parts share a common grounding point . The wire is usually yellow-green insulated, with a cross-sectional area meeting local electrical codes to ensure proper conductivity and safety .

### Installation Steps

- Locate the grounding point: Identify the PE bar or grounding plate inside the distribution box .
- Connect the ground wire: Strip the copper wire and attach it securely to the PE bar using screws, ensuring a firm connection .
