These connectors lock and clamp wires securely, preventing loosening under load and ensuring long-term reliability (). 4. **Industrial Plugs and Cable Glands:** Industrial plugs are used for circuits that need to be frequently connected or disconnected, while cable glands provide strain relief and environmental protection for incoming and outgoing cables ().

Wiring Practices

In a typical single-phase domestic distribution box:

- The main supply (phase and neutral) is connected to the main MCB or isolator.
- From the main MCB, power is routed to an RCCB for leakage protection.
