Purpose of Wiring Holes

- **Mark the Location:** Identify the exact position for the hole based on wiring layout and conduit entry points. Ensure it does not interfere with internal components like breakers or busbars .
- **Cut or Punch the Hole:** Carefully cut or punch the hole, keeping edges smooth to prevent wire insulation damage. Remove any burrs or sharp edges using a file or deburring tool .
- **Install Conduit or Grommet:** Insert a conduit connector, bushing, or grommet to protect wires and maintain compliance with electrical codes .
