

Wiring method for 24-core fiber optic cable



Summary of Content

24-core fiber optic cables are typically wired using MTP/MPO connectors with careful routing, splicing, and distribution to maximize density and minimize signal loss.

High-Density Cabling with MTP/MPO

For high-speed networks (40G/100G), 24-core MTP/MPO cabling is commonly used due to its compact design and high connection density. A single 24-core MTP connector can replace multiple 8- or 12-fiber cables, significantly reducing space requirements in patch panels and distribution modules. These cables can be connected to 24-core MTP-LC fiber distribution modules, which split the 24 fibers into individual LC connections for equipment ports, allowing seamless integration with existing network hardware and supporting scalable upgrades .

Installation Guidelines

Proper handling and routing are critical to maintain fiber integrity:

- Avoid sharp bends and kinks; maintain smooth curves and use large-radius turns where possible .
- Figure-8 loops are recommended when laying cable on the ground to prevent twisting and mechanical stress. Typical loop sizes range from 2 to 4 meters depending on cable stiffness .
- Protective sheathing should remain in place until installation, especially for outdoor or LSZH cables, to prevent damage from environmental exposure or mechanical stress .
