

Wiring steps for residential distribution boxes

Follow color coding standards: typically, phase (live) wires are brown or red, neutral wires are blue, and ground wires are green/yellow. Ensure wires are free from damage and meet electrical specifications.

Step 3: Circuit Breaker Installation

Install individual circuit breakers according to the electrical load requirements. Each breaker protects a specific circuit and should match the wire gauge and expected current.
